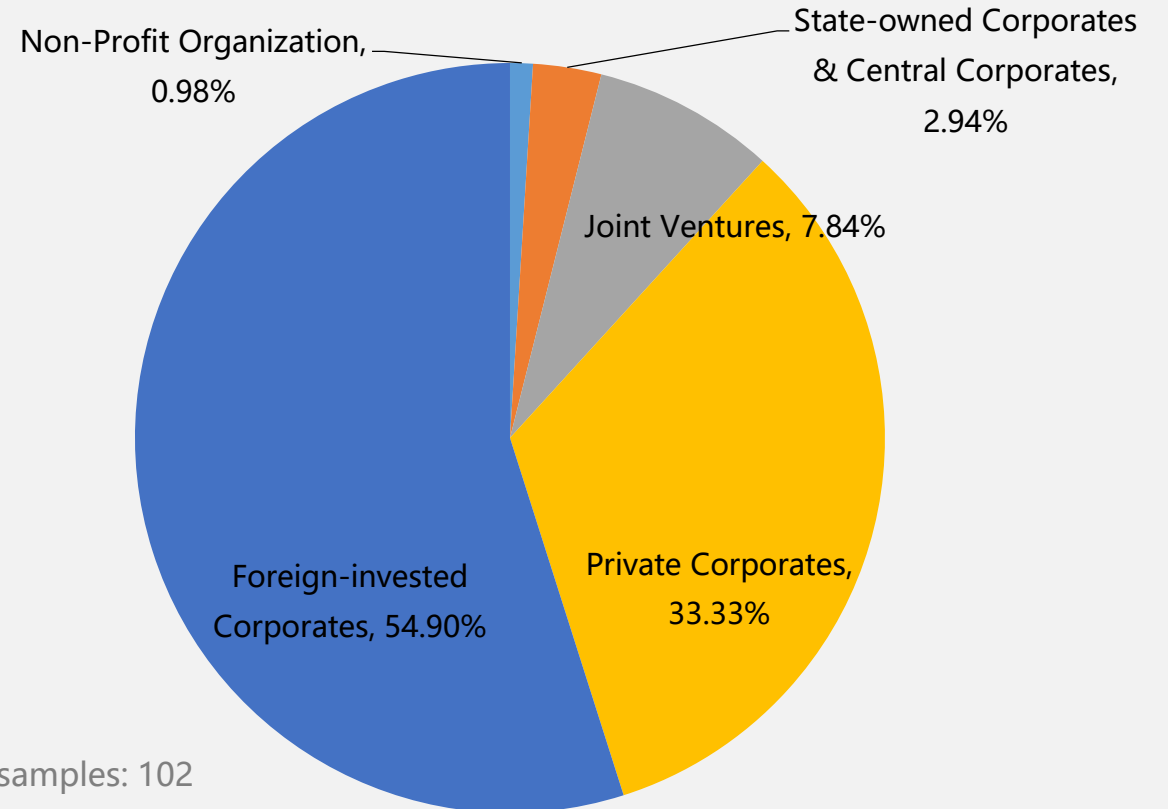

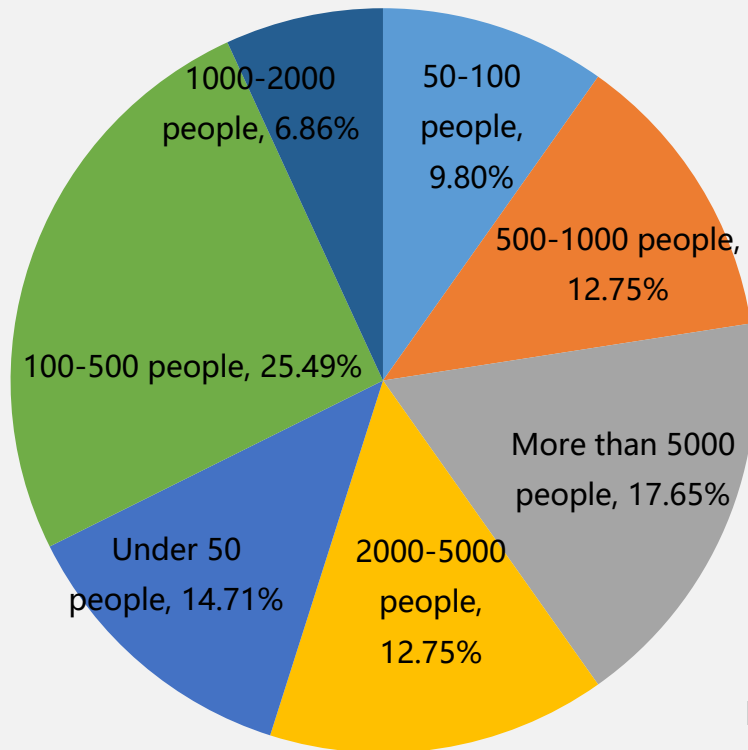

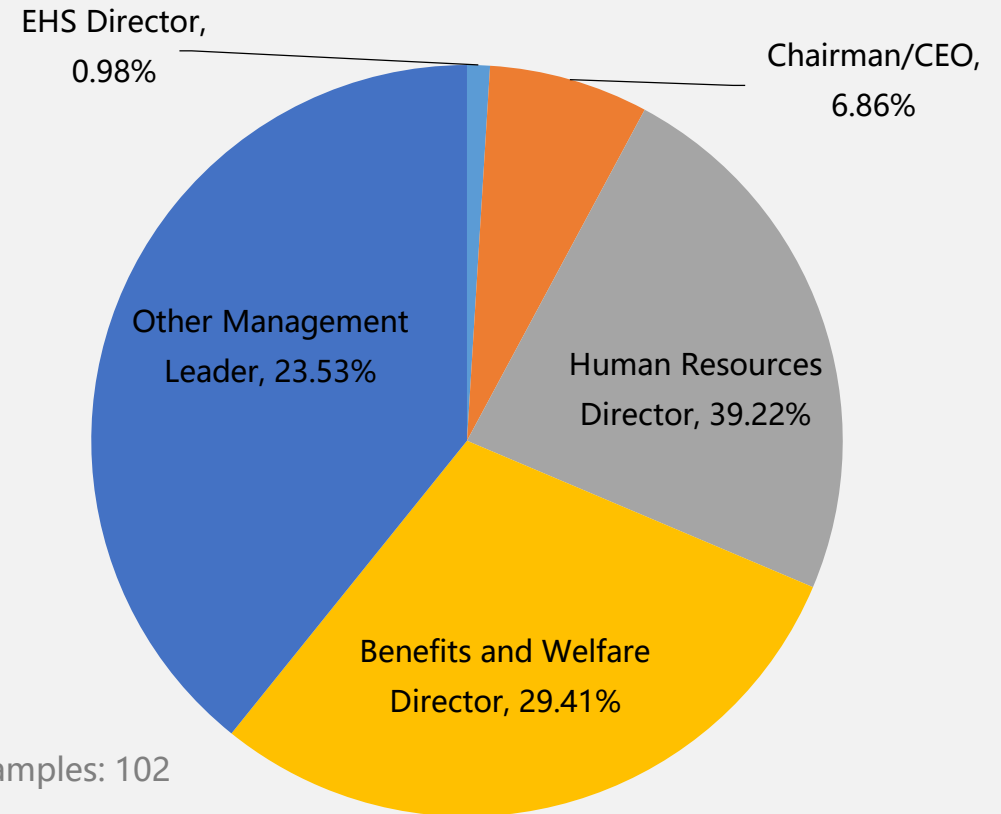

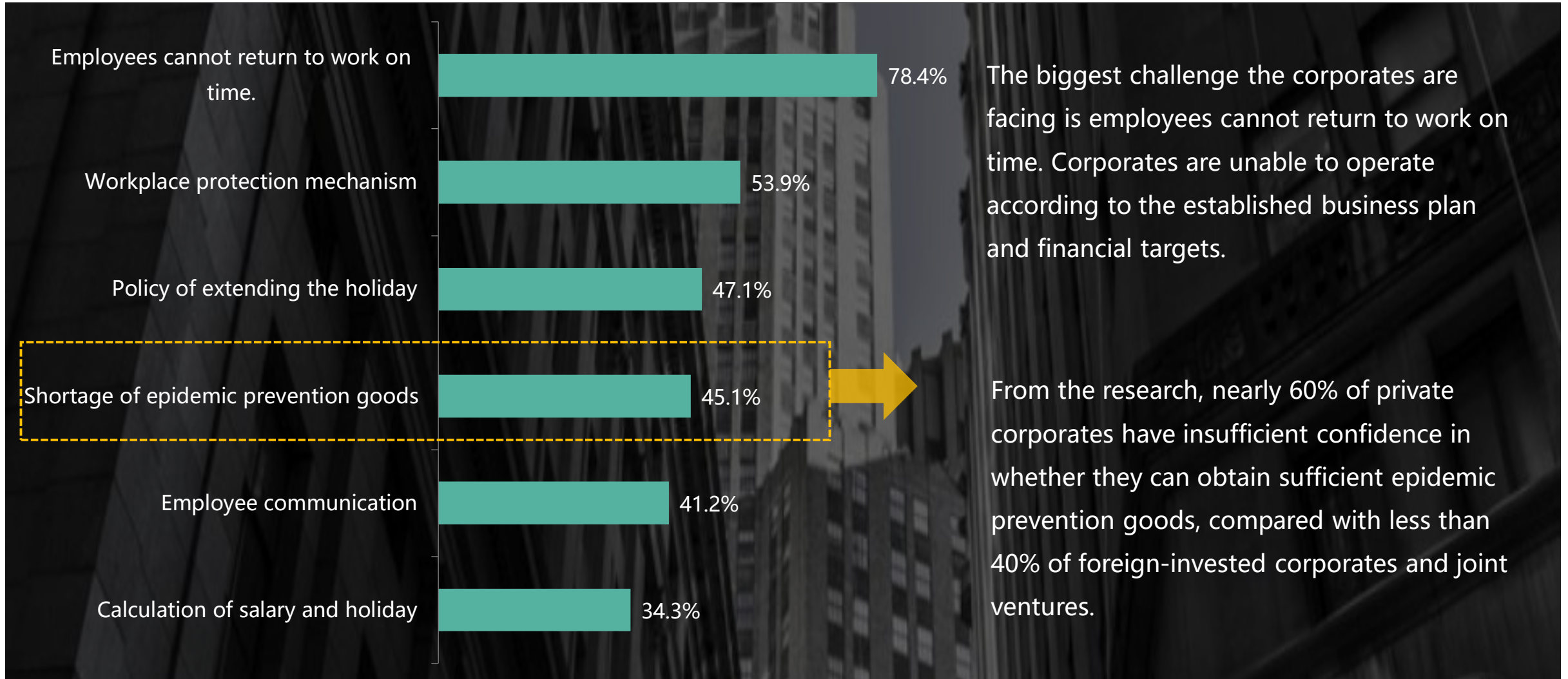

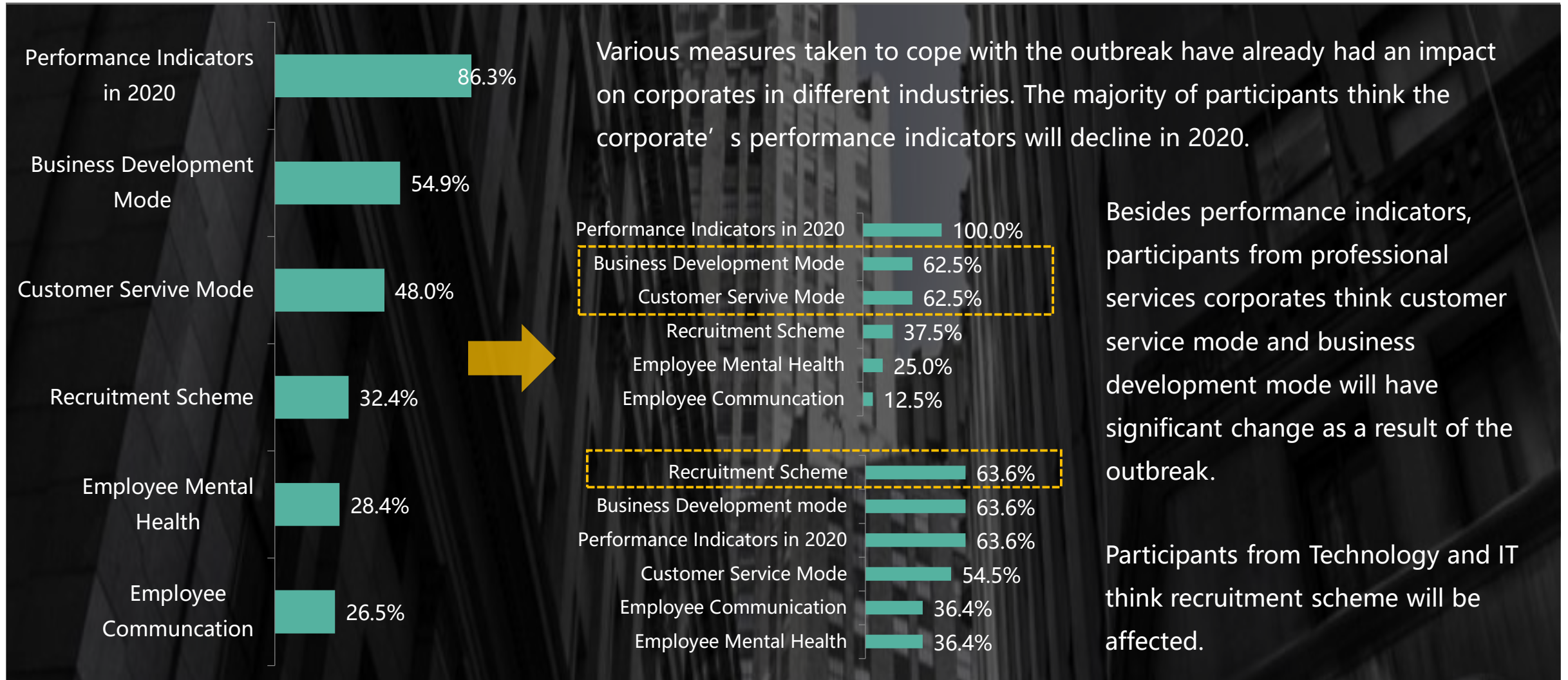

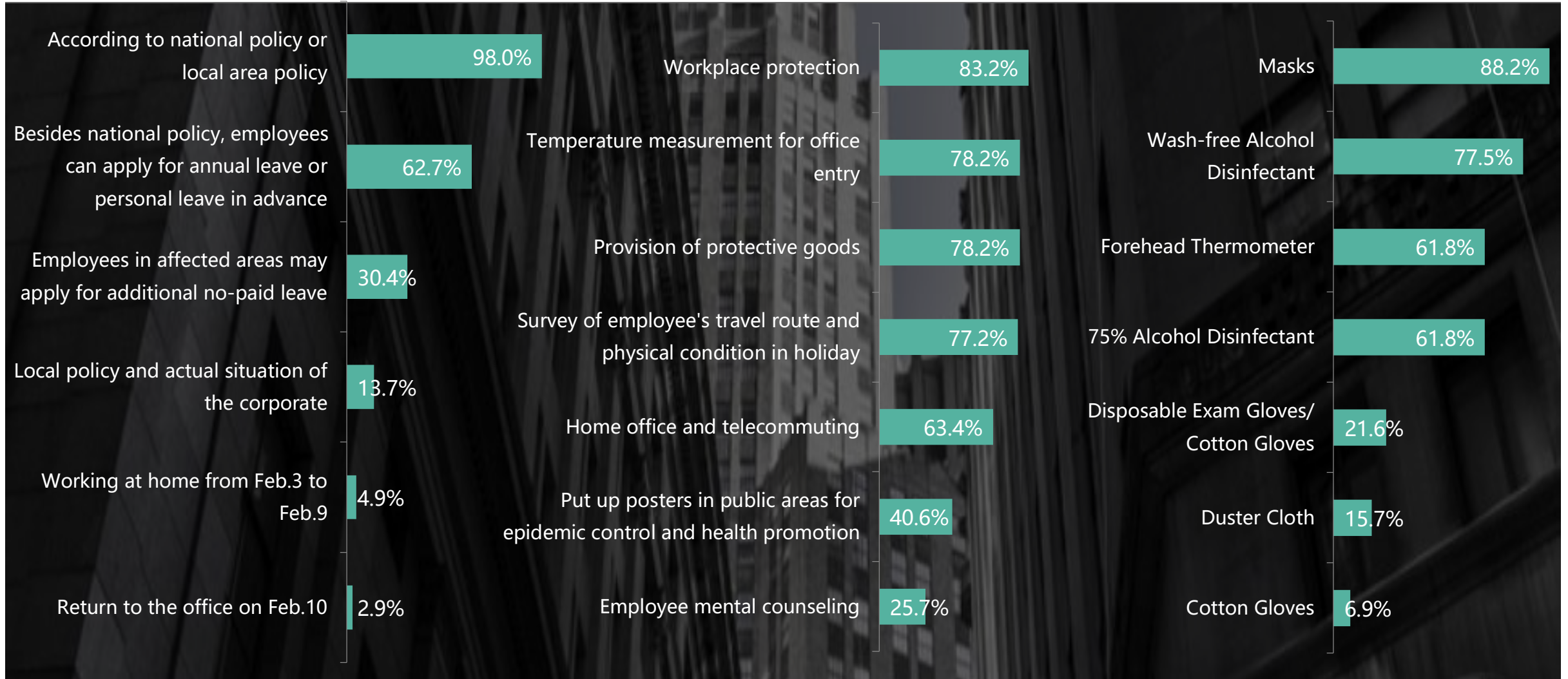

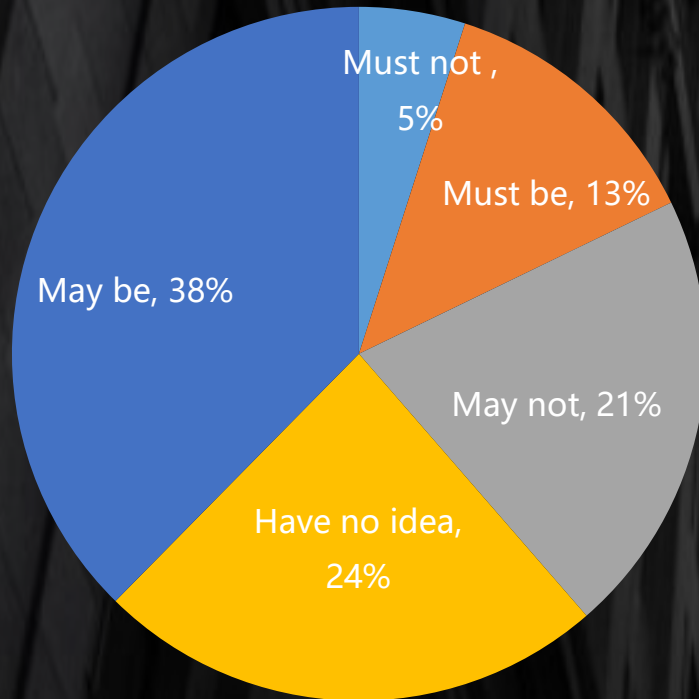

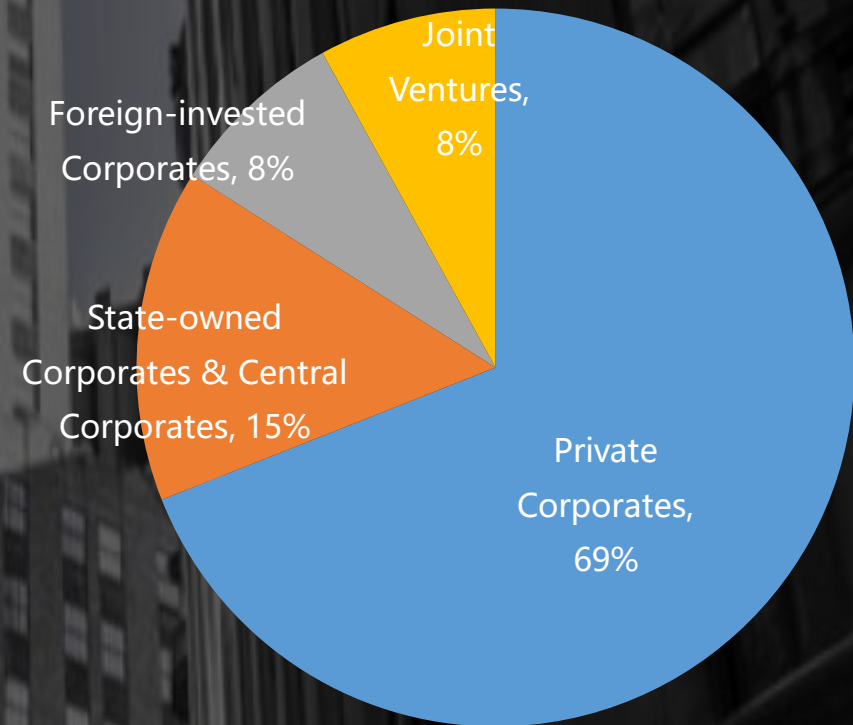

Most corporates hold a wait-and-see attitude towards the future talent strategy



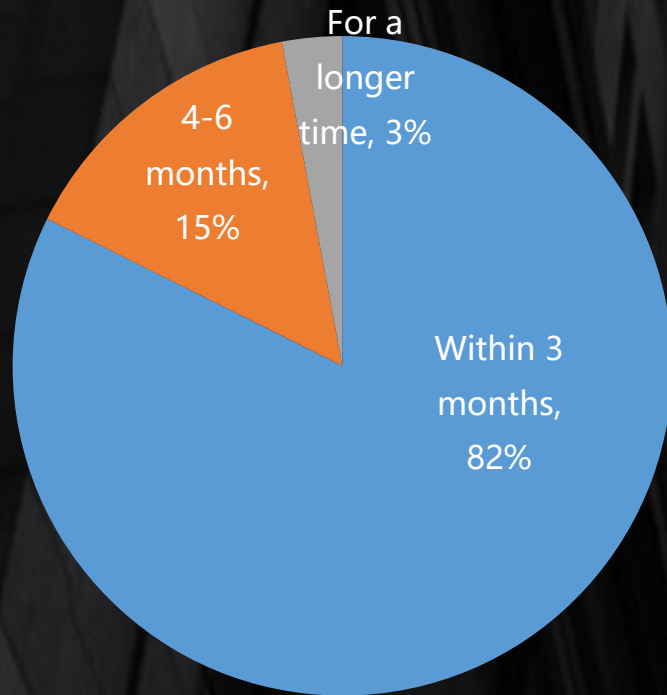
Private corporates are more efficient in responding to the outbreak



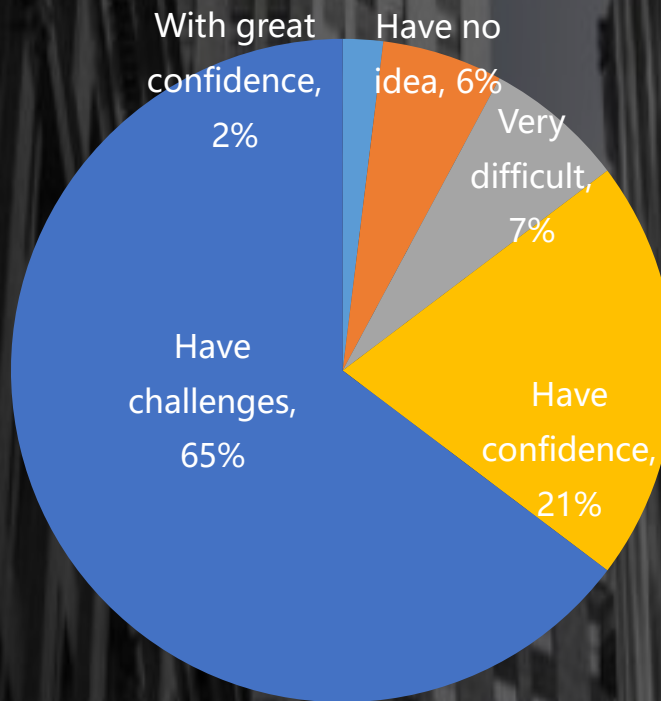

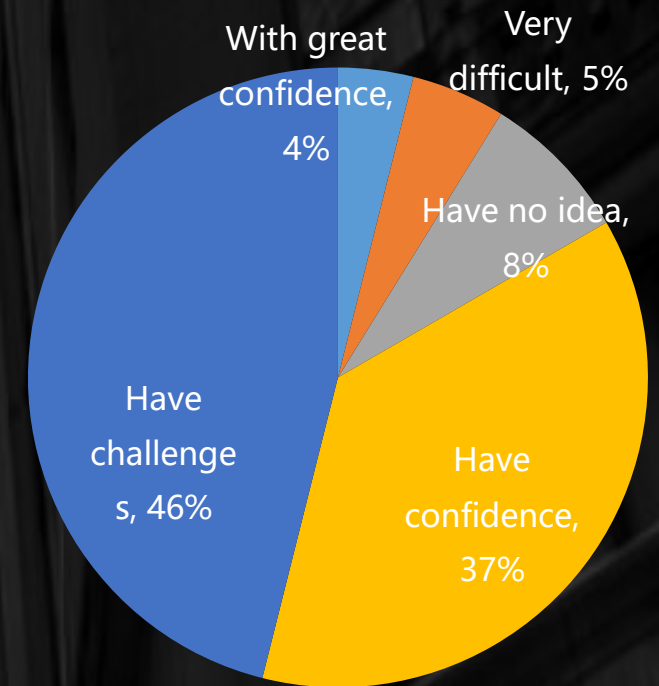
Most corporates are optimistic about controlling the outbreak

Management Challenges for Corporates

- The biggest challenge the corporates are facing is employees cannot return to work on time.
- Nearly 60% of private corporates have insufficient confidence in whether they can obtain sufficient epidemic prevention goods, compared with less than 40% of foreign-invested corporates and joint ventures.
- Education, real estate and other industries are the top three industries who choose the biggest challenge the corporates are facing is “employees cannot return to work on time” .



Main Impact for Corporates in 2020

- Most of corporates think the main impact of the outbreak is “performance indicators will fall in 2020” and the rate will high to 86.3%.
- Participants from professional services corporates think customer service mode and business development mode will have significant change as a result of the outbreak.
- Participants from Technology and IT corporates think recruitment scheme will be affected.
- Industries of professional services, consumable products and real estate are the top three industries who choose “performance indicators will fall in 2020” .



Delay of Work Resumption and Precaution at Workplace

- To ensure employees ‘ health and safety, 98% of corporates set rework time according to national policy or local area policy.
- Workplace protection, temperature measurement for office entry and provision of protective goods are the top three safety measures.
- Mass, wash-free alcohol disinfectant are the first choice of provision of protective goods when employees return to work.
